Lumana'i Awards 2012

Recognizing & Honoring Outstanding Samoan Youth

Open to all Oahu high school seniors of **Samoan ancestry** who are in good academic standing. Eligible criteria include: strong record of scholastic achievement and potential; demonstrate leadership abilities through participation in community service, co-curricular or other activities; and proof of acceptance into a post high school institution, if selected. Outstanding recipient in each category (15 total) will receive \$500. **Deadline is Friday, March 9, 2012.**

Hawaii Land Surveyors Association Student Scholarship Award

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to the undergraduate student pursuing a degree in land surveying from an ABET accredited college or university. Requirements include a minimum GPA of 3.0 and a written statement about applicant's financial needs, extracurricular activities, goals, awards, and work history. Ke Ali'i Pauahi Foundation Scholarships

This foundation offers a number of scholarships. Each scholarship has unique eligibility criteria. Scholarships are open to the general public. However it is the policy of this foundation to give preference to applicants with Hawaiian ancestry. **Application Guide** and a **listing of scholarships** are available online at www.pauahi.org. (The Application Guide is available for viewing in the College and Career Center.) Application will be available online starting February 16, 2011. **Deadline is 4:15pm, March 30, 2012.**

Hawaii Education Association (HEA)

Applicant must be a deserving high school senior who is a HEA member, or a child of a HEA member, or grandchild of a HEA member. Members must be in good standing and shall have been members for at least one year. Selection is based on: personal statement, abilities, teacher recommendations, and financial need. **Deadline is April 2, 2012**

Buick Achievers Scholarship Program

Applicant must: enroll in full-time undergraduate study at a U.S. based four-year college or university, plan to major in a course of study that focuses on Engineering/Technology or select Design and business related programs of study, demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career in the automotive or related industries using these areas of study. Selection is based on the following criteria: academic achievement, financial need, Participation and leadership in community and school activities, work experience, and special consideration will be given to the following applicants; first-generation college, female, minority, military veteran or a dependent of military personnel. American society of Military Comptrollers (ASMC)

This award is designed to recognize graduating high school seniors for academic achievement and to provide financial assistance in order that they may accomplish their future financial management baccalaureate educational goals. Applicant must be entering a field of study directly related to financial/resource management. Award selection criteria include: scholastic achievements, leadership ability, extracurricular activities, career/academic goals and financial need. **Deadline is March 15, 2012.**

Student Insights 2012 Student-View Scholarship Program

This is for seniors who plan to attend four-year college, community/junior college or career school. There is NO essay, NO ACT/SAT scores. Scholarships range from \$500 to \$4,000. All the applicant needs to do is log on to www.student-view.com and complete a 15-20 minute application survey about colleges in your area. The scholarship is awarded via a random drawing of all completed applications. **Deadline is April 22, 2012.**

HMSA Kaimana Awards

Scholarship recipients will be selected from each high school athletic league and division statewide. Applicant must: have a minimum GPA of 2.75; have played on at least one school athletic team in a league-sanctioned sport during at least one of their high school years (special consideration will be given to student athletes in lower-profile sports.) ; and participated in a number of community service projects in addition to school services. **Deadline is 4:00pm, February 17, 2012.**

Prince Kuhi'o Hawaiian Civic Club Scholarship (PKHCC)

Applicants must: be of Hawaiian ancestry, have a GPA of 2.5 or better, and demonstrate academic and leadership potential. Also required are a resume, letter of recommendation and an essay on the following question: "*What Hawaiian issue influenced your decision pursue your course of study in college/university?*" If awarded a PKHCC scholarship, applicants are expected to embrace the PKHCC mission of community service, leadership, participation, and perpetuating the Hawaiian culture. Kiewit Building Group

Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 and intend to pursue a major engineering, architecture, or construction management. An essay is required. Essay should address the following topics: academic performance, academic/professional goals, financial need, extracurricular activities, a statement on why applicant should be considered, and other comments to assist in the application process. **Deadline is March 31, 2012.**

Alexander Hamilton Award

Winners receive: \$500 cash scholarship, leadership training in Seattle (2013) and in Guatemala (2014), college application assistance, scholarship search assistance, and much more. A Hamilton Award Winner is: a Junior who is college bound, has a strong record of community service, is a self-starter, shows passion and commitment to their interests, financial need, and is committed to enrolling in the Hamilton Leadership Academy.
