**VFW – VOICE OF DEMOCRACY.** Scholarship is open to **grades 9-12, 3-5 minute audio-essay** on the subject of **“My Role in Honoring America’s Veteran’s”**. Students can enter by submitting the required entry form along with their essay and recording to a local VFW Post. Dead line November 1, 2007

**HEALD COLLEGE – SERVICE AND LEADERSHIP (SAL) SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**  
Students to have a **2.0 GPA**, documentation of Service and Leadership Activities, **100-500 word essay** explaining why you would be a worthy recipient of the Service and Leadership Scholarship. Scholarships start at \$1200 (\$600 per quarter) and apply to tuition only. **Deadline February 19, 2008**

**HEALD COLLEGE – MERIT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM** Scholarships are open to students demonstrating strong academic potential, **3.0 GPA for the most recent quarter/semester completed**. Scholarships are tuition only and valued from \$1200.00 per quarter for three quarters or one academic year. **Deadline February 19, 2008.**

**SAE 2008 ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIPS** Various scholarships are open to high school seniors who intend to earn a degree in engineering or a related science degree. Must be a US citizen and meet minimum requirements as outlined in the individual requirements for each scholarship. Undesignated Scholarships range from \$1000 to \$10,000. University Sponsored Scholarships range from \$400 to full tuition. **Deadline December 1, 2007.**
